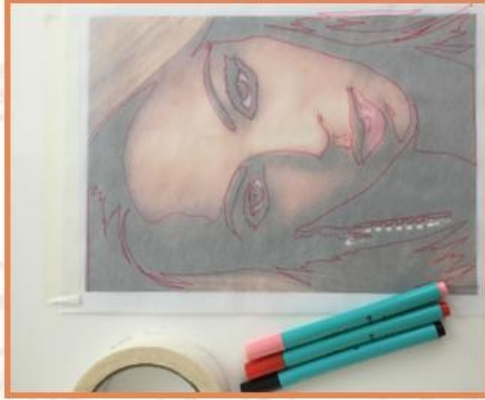


Portraits – Layering Line



1. Use the lightest colour pen and draw using line around your portrait. Ensure you draw in the shape of the face, the facial features and the hair.

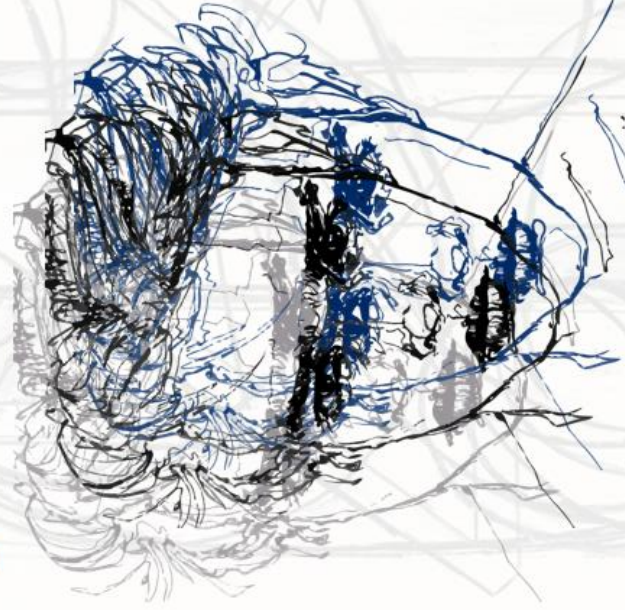


2. Use the second colour pen. **Move** your tracing paper across to the left and down. Now draw around the outline of your portrait again.



3. Finally take the black pen and move your tracing paper across to the right so it isn't in the same position as the original drawing. Draw around the portrait for the final time.

Layering Line



Artist such as Jasper Johns, Michael Craig Martin and Moisés Mahiques use layers of lines to create their artwork. Some artists focus upon portraits, some look at still life and others at typography and numbers.
